The 8.9km section of Koolmoon Creek track from Walters Waterhole camping area to the junction with Elizabeth Grant Falls track is closed. The 6.5km section of Cannabullen Creek track from Hinson Creek camping area to Carter Creek camping area is closed. All camping areas remain open.
Girramay NP	No gas barbecue facilities - Murray Falls, Girramay National Park.	There are no longer any gas barbecue facilities at Murray Falls day-use area.
Kirrama National Park	Temporary park closure: Kirrama National Park.	Kirrama National Park remains closed due to damage to Kirrama Range Road caused by Cyclone Yasi. The Cassowary Coast Regional Council have advised that the road is anticipated to open October 2014.
Goldsborough Valley, Wooroonooran National Park	Gas barbecues at Goldsborough Valley unavailable.	The gas barbecues at Goldsborough Valley are currently unavailable. Wood barbecues are provided. Bring your own firewood as it cannot be collected from the park.
