

WHAT TO DO IN MISSION BEACH TODAY!

ACTIVE

- White Water Rafting on the Tully River. It's even better in the rain!
- Take a trip to the reef.
- Enjoy a rainforest walk on one of the clearly defined tracks. More frogs & other creatures.
 - Lacey's Creek
 - Licuala Fan Palm Walk
 - Bicton Hill
 - Edmund Kennedy Board Walk
- Join a Yoga/Pilates/Tai Chi class.
- Fishing off Clump Point jetty (or turtle spotting!)
- Go to Dunk Island- fish, swim, walk, snorkel
- Hire a Kayak or Stand Up Paddle Board
- Croc and Wildlife tours
- Jump the beach -do a Skydive! See the reef & rainforest from the sky and land on the beach.
- Kayak out to the islands
- Self drive a boat around the islands
- Jet ski on the beach or over to Dunk
- Ride a bike through the Ulysses track
- Walk to the old logging tracks (Musgravea Track)



LOCAL GEMS

- Browse through library books or watch a video of local attractions @ the Visitors Centre
- Visit C4 –Wet Tropics Environment Info Centre & learn about Cassowaries and the Wet Tropics
- Check out the local art scene in the Helen Wiltshire Gallery & the Arts Centre @ MARCS Park
- Spoil yourself with a massage or a beauty treatment.
- A beach walk – find the sand dollars!
- Cassowary spotting
- Cutten Brothers Historical Walk
- Old Mission Site- a local history spot
- Enjoy a BBQ on the water – or grab some local fish and chips to eat at several BBQ sites on our local beaches
- Visit Charleys' Chocolate for a tour
- Visit the Fruit Forest Fam. Exotic Fruit Tour. See how it's grown on a tropical fruit farm. Saturdays 2.30pm.
- Markets on a Sunday morning (check for times)
- Visit Raya the sting ray – a mosaic masterpiece
- Check out the Board walk –Edmund Kennedy Track
- Take a drive around the local farmlands (Bingil Bay loop)
- Enjoy swimming at freshwater swimming holes (Alligators Nest, Waterfall Circuit)

IN THE REGION

- Visit Tully Sugar Mill (June-Nov). Booking through Visitors Information Centre (essential).
- Explore Tully Gorge, enjoy a picnic in the National Park on the riverside.
- Go White Water Rafting on the mighty Tully River. Only 45 min away.
- Visit Paronella Park: voted QLD #1 must do!
- Or combine Paronella Park and Mamu Tropical Skywalk- a full day if you like
- Drive to Mourilyan to see the only Sugar Industry Museum in Australia. Return via Murdering Point Winery.
- Drive to Ingham & admire the magnificent Wallaman Falls. Have lunch @ Port Hinchinbrook
- Do a pub crawl: visit the historic country pubs in El Arish, Mena Creek, Silkwood, Mourilyan, Garradunga, Great counter lunches!
- Go for a chopper flight over the reef



BEACHES & ISLANDS

- Enjoy 14 km of golden sandy beaches.
- Hire a bicycle & enjoy cycling along the beach.
- Take a snorkel/dive trip to the Great Barrier Reef. Do a BBQ Lunch
- Have a picnic on one of the tropical islands. Swim/snorkel/explore!
- Take a Three Island Tour to the gorgeous Family group of Islands
- Hire a dinghy at South Mission Beach and go fishing on the Hull River or go to Dunk Island.
- Hire a catamaran, surf ski or kayak from South Mission Beach or bikes & blowkarts from North Mission Beach.
- Take a guided kayak tour along the coastline or to the islands.
- Go fishing or crabbing: plenty of opportunities!

DRIVING AND WALKING AND VISITING

- Visit the Information Centre (VIC) and the Environment Centre (C4). Watch a video on Cassowaries.
- Do a self guided rainforest walk & search for the endangered Cassowary. Get a map from the Information Centre.
- Lots of day drives, fresh water swimming, picnic spots, waterfalls, historic country pubs. Free maps & leaflets from the VIC.
- Visit Mission Arts, the Community Arts Centre.
- Visit any of the local markets (Sundays)
- Drive the Waterfall Circuit in the Lower Tablelands & have lunch in Millaa Millaa.
- Bird watching – a twitchers paradise!
